HISTORY OF STEP SING

Step Sing began as a sing-along on the steps of Renfroe Hall at the Howard College East Lake Campus in 1951, making 2024 a celebration of 74 years of Step Sing. Sponsored by the Women's Service Organization, it was originally held once a semester and soon began to take the form of a competition. In the late 1950's, campus organizations decided to gather only once a year in December. They moved the competition to the steps of "Old Main," where each group sang two songs.

In 1957, Howard College moved to its present location on Lakeshore Drive, bringing with it the tradition of Step Sing. Many changes, including the addition of costumes and props, took place during the 1960's. In 1966, emcees became a part of the action, and in 1967, each group began choosing a theme around which to base its show.

In 1971, Step Sing celebrated its twentieth anniversary, and the Sweepstakes Trophy was added. A few years later, the first band accompanied the performances. In 1976, Step Sing was moved to its current home in the Wright Center.

Groups began using recorded music instead of the Step Sing band in the early 1990's, and the committee began awarding "Participants' Choice Award" to the cast members' favorite show.

Under the direction of the Division of Student Affairs and the Office of Student Activities and Events, Step Sing is organized by students, including music arrangement, choreography, and costume design. Step Sing has become an educational activity in which the students participate through leadership development, organizational administration and time management, and continues to be one of the most popular traditions at Samford.

STEP SING SCHOLARSHIP

In celebration of the 74th year of Step Sing, we will maintain the Step Sing Endowed Scholarship, which was established in 2020. Through the years, students at Samford University have worked tirelessly to keep this tradition thriving, and Step Sing is thrilled to acknowledge these students and their academic pursuits.

All Step Sing participants with at least one undergraduate semester remaining were eligible to apply to receive funds from the Step Sing Endowed Scholarship. We will be announcing the recipients on stage following the Saturday evening performance.

BANNER DROP

Step Sing has developed many traditions over the years. Before Spring classes begin, students gather on campus for the event that officially kicks off the Step Sing season, Banner Drop. Held this year in the Wright Center, each group let their banner drop from above to reveal their show's title and theme. It is a tradition that each show's theme be kept secret until as close to the show opening as possible. Because of this, at Banner Drop, the title and banner are creatively used to throw off those that are not in the show! The banners are judged at this event, and the first-place group participants have the first choice for participant tickets. Following Banner Drop, the banners are displayed in the Pete Hanna Center and then moved for the show weekend to the Wright Center Lobby for our in-house audience to enjoy!



JUDGING

Shows are judged during both Friday and Saturday evening performances by a different panel of judges who were selected for their qualification in one of the following categories: Music, Choreography, Theatre, Student Affairs, or Samford Alumni.

Although each judge is selected for his or her experience in a specific area, each judge gives a score in every category. The combination of expert and novice opinions rewards the most well-rounded group that is both technically proficient and entertaining.

Judges do not see the shows before scoring to prevent bias. Score sheets are collected during intermission and at the end of the show to allow judges to score each half, account for the fact that they have not seen the show before and account for any potential bias caused by the order of the show.

Each show's highest and lowest scores are dropped, and the middle scores are averaged to provide the final score.

SCORING

Each show will receive a score of up to 100 points from each judge with a maximum of the following point values:

ENTERTAINMENT VALUE || 30 points

MUSICAL QUALITY || 20 points (10 points for Song Selection & Arrangement and 10 points for Execution)

CHOREOGRAPHY || 20 points (10 points for Difficulty & Design and 10 points for Execution)

THEME DEVELOPMENT || 15 points

CREATIVITY || 15 points

JUDGED AWARDS

The primary awards decided by the score of our judges are:

SWEEPSTAKES AWARD || Awarded to the group with the highest score overall.

FIRST RUNNER UP || Awarded to the group with the second highest score.

SECOND RUNNER UP || Awarded to the group with the third highest score.

The excellence awards are awarded to the groups with the highest score in a certain category given by the judges. The excellence awards are:

EXCELLENCE IN MUSIC || Awarded to the group with the most points in the Music category.

EXCELLENCE IN CHOREOGRAPHY || Awarded to the group with the most points in the Choreography category.

EXCELLENCE IN CREATIVITY || Awarded to the group with the most points in the Creativity category.

ADDITIONAL AWARDS

COMMITTEE CHOICE AWARDS || After spending extensive time working with the show directors and watching the shows develop from ideas to performance, the Step Sing Committee votes on which shows to recognize for having the Favorite Moment, Favorite Song, and Directors of the Year.

PARTICIPANT CHOICE AWARDS || Participants can vote for their favorite Step Sing show in the following categories: Music, Choreography, Costumes, and Emcee.

SPIRIT OF STEP SING AWARD || The Spirit of Step Sing Award is given to one member of each group chosen by the show directors as someone who embodies the energy and attitude of Step Sing.

STEP SING CHARACTER AWARD || Established in 2016, this is awarded to the group who demonstrates a spirit of congeniality and character in their actions on the stage and behind the scenes. This award is voted on by the Overall Step Sing Committee, the Office of Student Activities and Events, and the Wright Center Staff.

STEP SING PHILANTHROPY AWARD || The Philanthropy Award is presented to the Step Sing group who has raised the most money in donations to our philanthropy. The QR code that is included previously in this program keeps track of how much each group has donated and at the end of the four shows, the group that has the most donations receives the Philanthropy Award.

FRIDAY NIGHT JUDGES

GEORGE WILSON-BERRY || Instructor of Dance, University of Alabama

George Wilson-Berry is an educator and choreographer with an MFA in Dance from the University of Alabama. His work has been featured at Broadway Dance Center, Young Choreographer's Festival, Alabama Dance Festival, and Benjamin Briones' The Round Table. Recently, he choreographed the Rocky Horror Show at the University of Alabama and served as the Assistant Director/Choreographer of Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat at Red Mountain Theatre.

KENDRA GILES || Company Dancer, Sanspointe; Choreographer and Guest Artist, Magic City Performing Arts

Kendra is a professional dancer, choreographer, and educator based in the Birmingham area. Professional dance organizations include Sanspointe Dance Company, Gradient Dance Theatre, and Magic City Performing Arts. Kendra is a dance instructor for Mt. Laurel Ballet, UAB ArtPlay, Gradient Dance Community, and The Dance Foundation.

MATTHEW HOCH || Professor of Voice, Auburn University

Matthew Hoch is professor of voice at Auburn University. He is the author and editor of several books, numerous peer-reviewed articles, and serves as an associate editor for the NATS Journal of Singing and the ACDA Choral Journal. He holds a DMA from the New England Conservatory and a certificate in vocology from the National Center for Voice and Speech.

BRITTANY JORDAN || Assistant Director, The University of Alabama (Office of Fraternity & Sorority Life)

Brittany Jordan is originally from Florence, AL where she is a 2-time alumnae from the University of North Alabama, receiving her bachelor's degree in 2013 and her master's degree last fall. She is no stranger to performing on stage, during undergrad she competed in pageants and was a majorette in the UNA Marching band.

LAUREN MARINO || Social Media Manager and Samford Alumna

Lauren Marino serves as Samford University's social media manager. Lauren is a proud Samford alumna (and past Step Sing participant); she received her degrees in Journalism Mass Communication and Vocal Performance in 2016. In addition to her work in advertising agencies, Lauren has performed opera on a local and national level, acted in numerous SEC Shorts comedy sketches that air on social media and television, as well as local theatre productions. She is a member of the American Marketing Association, the American Advertising Federation, CASE, the Samford Communication and Media Advisory Council, Staff Advisory Council, Events Council, serves as an SGA Functional Advisor, and Opera Birmingham.

BYRON MOSQUERA || Director of Choirs, Homewood High School

Byron Mosquera is in his 7th year of directing the show choirs at Homewood High School. He's choreographed for many groups in Alabama since 2011. In his free time, Byron enjoys traveling the world.

BRYANT HENDERSON SHEA || The University of Alabama, Department of Theatre & Dance

Bryant Henderson Shea (MFA), is a nationally-recognized dancer and dance educator and adjunct professor in the MFA Dance Program at The University of Alabama. Bryant is a highly regarded dance adjudicator serving as a judge for StageOne National Dance Competitions, and is the Director of Judges for Dance Troupe Inc. Bryant has held professorships at Cleveland State University, Willamette University, and Lane Community College, and was a dancer & aerialist for Celebrity Cruises.

DR. SARAH THERESA WEE || Assistant Professor of Voice, Troy University

Soprano Sarah Wee is an Assistant Professor of Voice at Troy University where she teaches private lessons, vocal pedagogy, diction, and directs the Opera Workshop. Dr. Wee received her Doctorate of Musical Arts in Vocal Performance and Vocal Pedagogy at the Frost School of Music at the University of Miami, where she later served as a lecturer in the voice department. A Birmingham native, University of Montevallo alum, and long-time local stage actor, and choreographer. As the Artistic Director of the STARS Education Program at Virginia Samford Theatre, Jenna has the great pleasure of teaching, directing, and producing musical theatre with the amazing young talent of this city every day. She's no stranger to serving as a judge for theatre festivals, and dance competitions - and is thrilled to enjoy these fantastic Step Sing performances.

JOAN BUTTRAM || Professor Emeritus, University of Georgia Department of Dance

Joan Buttram, a University of Georgia Department of Dance Associate Professor, recently retired to pursue new artistic ventures. Founding Artistic Director of the UGA Ballet Ensemble, Joan restaged full-length classical ballets and created choreographic works for professional and regional dance companies. Her professional performance career included principal and soloist roles and guest artists in residency positions; Joan has instructed modern dance and ballet technique classes at professional schools nationally and internationally. Jones is also Founder and CEO of SongLever, Inc., a school resource curriculum that uses songwriting and technology to enhance engagement, improve learning, and foster creativity for students in public schools.

SHAWN KNIGHT || Assistant Professor of Performance, Belmont University

Shawn Knight is a professional Equity performer and playwright based in Nashville, TN. He serves as the head of the BFA in Performance in Belmont University's Department of Theatre and Dance, performs ten self-written one-man shows, and instructs and directs theatre practitioners from the pre-school to professional adult levels.

ROY LIGHTNER || Artistic Director, Red Mountain Theatre - Professor of Musical Theatre, UAB

His work as a creator, director, and choreographer spans internationally including productions and immersive events for GOOGLE, Lincoln Center, the Stephen Sondheim Center, Red Mountain Theatre, Transcendence Theatre Company, MTWichita, and more totaling over 60 productions worldwide. He has won 5 National Kennedy Center American College Theatre Festival awards. He serves as the Artistic Director for two-time TONY Award winning theatre, Red Mountain Theatre.

JENNIFER LUCK || Visiting Assistant Professor, Birmingham-Southern College

Jennifer Luck is a theatre artist and educator returning to the Birmingham area after decades working throughout the country. Whether designing scenery, lighting, and projections or implementing designs as a technical director, she enjoys sharing her knowledge and skills with young artists.
